the ages of 16 and 24 and can be

in school or out of school.

REQUIREMENTS: Youth accepted into the program

will work 25 hours per week for eight weeks. The experience is comprised

of 21 hours per week with the

employer and an additional four

hours per week working on a virtual SkillUp Job Readiness program and a

separate virtual lifeskills program.

EMPLOYERS:

Twenty private and public employers in Hunterdon and Somerset counties have part-time positions available.

Position responsibilities include: supervising children and teens in summer programs; office and clerical work in county and municipal government offices; nonprofit administration support; school maintenance work; marketing assistance; construction assistance; and more.
